

Comparative and Superlative forms

<u>Short Adjectives</u> (1 syllable or 2 syllables + consonant + -y)

Adjective	Comparative	Superlative
general rule	adj. + -er + than	the adj. + -est
tall	taller than	the tallest in / of
great	greater than	the greatest
adj. ending in –e	adj. + -r + than	the adj. + -st
fine	finer than	the finest in / of
adj. ending in vowel + consonant	double consonant + -er + than	double consonant + est
big	bigger than	the biggest
hot	hotter than	the hottest
2 syllable adj. ending consonant + y	change the 'y' to 'i' + -er + than	change the 'y' to 'i' + -est
heavy	heavier than	the heaviest
pretty	prettier than	the prettiest

Long Adjectives (2 + syllables)

Adjective	Comparative	Superlative
general rule	more + adj. + than	the most + adj.
beautiful	more beautiful than	the most beautiful
interesting	more interesting than	the most interesting
adverbs ending in '-ly'	more + adverb + than	The most + adverb
friendly	more friendly than	the most friendly
carefully	more carefully than	the most carefully



<u>Irregular Comparatives and Superlatives</u>

Adjective / Adverb	Comparative form	Superlative form
good	better than	the best
bad	worse than	the worst
far	farther than further than	the farthest
little	less	the least
some / much / many	more	the most

Other ways of Making Comparisons

'less' and 'least' have the opposite meaning to 'more' and 'most'.	Emily was <u>less experienced</u> than us. She was <u>the least experienced</u> member of the team.
'as + adj./adverb + as' to compare people or things that are similar.	James was <u>as good as</u> his brother at maths. The second hotel we stayed at was <u>as impressive</u> <u>as</u> the first one.

Modifiers: much, a lot, a little, a bit, a good deal

This film is much worse than I thought it would be.

This holiday is <u>a lot more expensive than</u> the one we had last year.

Sarah's painting is a little less colourful than Adam's.

Your car is a little bit more reliable than mine.

This restaurant is a bit cheaper than the one near the fountain.

George's drawings are <u>much more realistic</u> than mine.

This recipe is <u>a good deal easier</u> to make than you might think.
